He has often returned to the Tribe's eastern homelands for responsibilities as needed. Traditional territory of the Mohican and Munsee people includes Yorktown. The presentation will include the history of the Tribe from their original homelands along the Mahicannituck, the "waters that are never still", to the many removals which resulted in the tribe ending up in its reservation today in northern Wisconsin. The traditions and current state of his people today will be covered as the Tribe continues to be active in its Eastern homelands.
